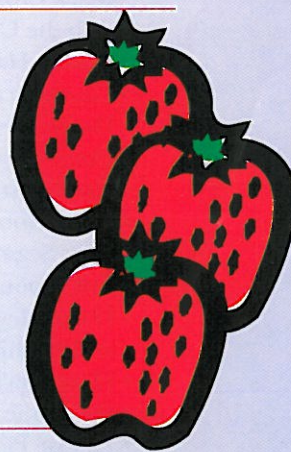

## DIRECTIONS

### FROM THE NORTH:

1-93 South to High/Congress Street; exit 23. At end of ramp, take the first left onto High Street. Go left at second light onto Congress Street. Cross the Congress Street bridge, Museum is behind the 40 foot milk bottle. NOTE: if exit is closed, take exit 22 to South Station. Go Left on Summer Street one block to make a left on Dorchester Avenue. Go one block to make a right on Congress Street. Cross the bridge.

### FROM THE SOUTH:

1-93 North to Downtown/Mass Pike/Chinatown exit. Bear left towards Boston. At the end of ramp, go left on Kneeland Street. Go one block and make a right onto Surface Street. Go several lights. Just past the Federal Reserve Building, make a right onto Congress Street. Cross Bridge and follow directions above.

### FROM THE WEST:

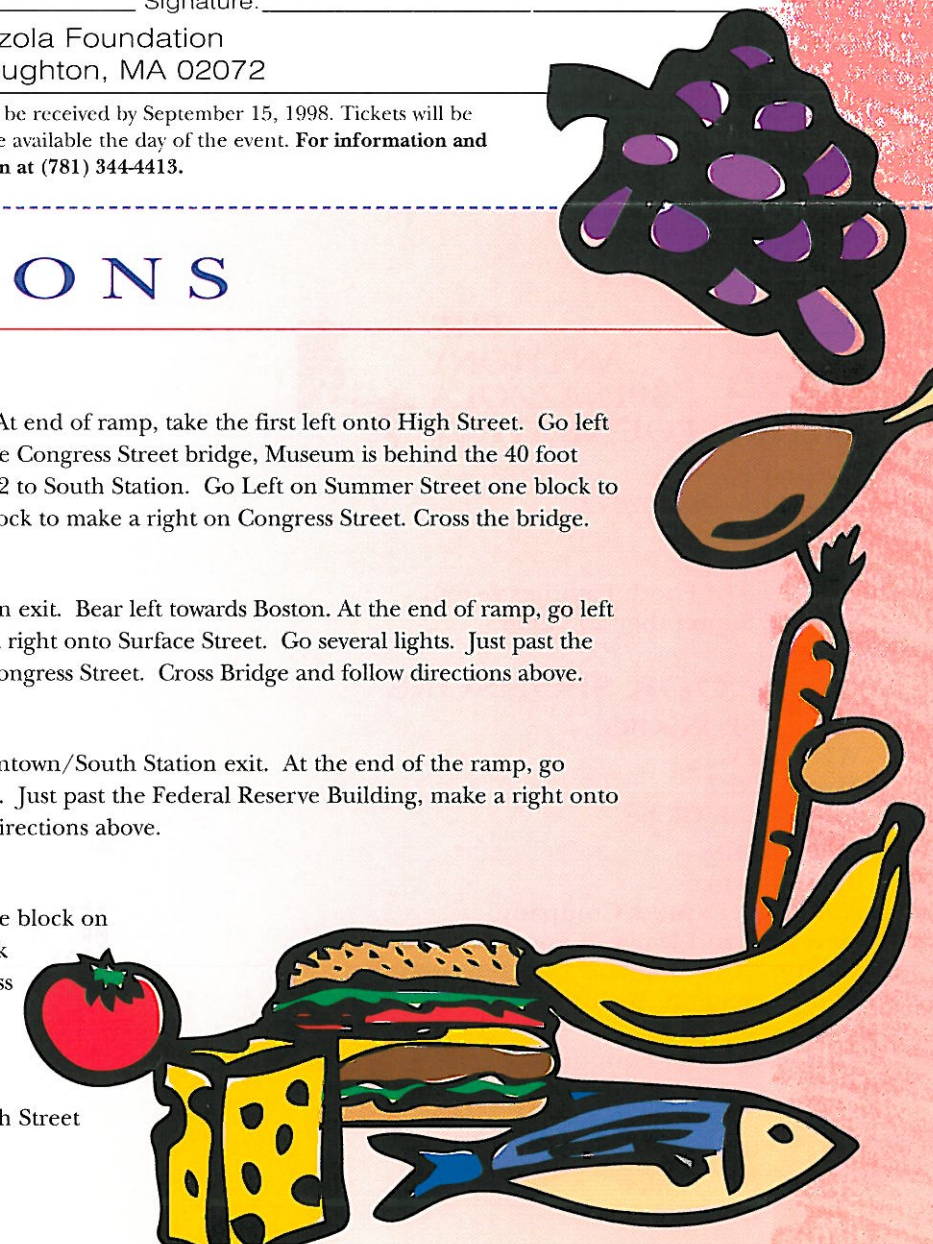
1-90 East (Mass Pike) to its end, take the Downtown/South Station exit. At the end of the ramp, go straight onto Surface Street. Go several lights. Just past the Federal Reserve Building, make a right onto Congress Street and cross bridge and follow directions above.

### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

Take the RED LINE to South Station, walk one block on Atlantic Avenue past the Federal Reserve Bank building, turn right onto Congress Street, cross Bridge. It's about a three block walk

### PARKING:

Discount parking is available in the Farnsworth Street Garage, two blocks past museum.
