

Plants from the Vegetable Bin

you will need:

a white potato, a sweet potato, a carrot, an onion, a garlic head, a beet and a pineapple. glass jars, saucers, toothpicks, sand, paper cups.

What to do:

What will happen:



white potato

cut in 3 parts. each part should have several eyes. plant each part in wet sand in paper cup.

stem, leaves & roots will grow from eyes.



sweet potato

suspend sweet potato in neck of jar of water. balance by putting toothpicks in it... water must cover bottom of potato.

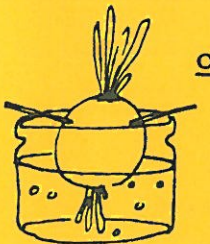
stem & leaves will grow from top... roots from bottom.



carrot

cut one inch off top of carrot. set top in saucer of water. never let dish get dry.

green stems and feathery leaves will sprout from top.



onion & garlic

support onion and garlic each in separate jar of water. use toothpicks to keep them partially submerged.

onion: long green leaves from top, white roots from bottom.
garlic: long green leaves will grow from top of each clove, white roots from bottom.

Beet

support in jar of water... small end down. use toothpicks if necessary.

same as sweet potato.



pineapple

make a 1" slice at top of pineapple. place in saucer of wet sand. keep moist.

green stalks and stems will fall out from old stalks at top.
