Recycle Monster Masks

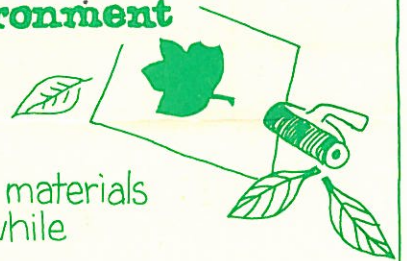

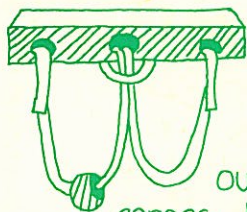


Travel Center

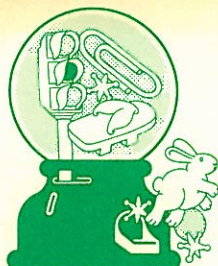
