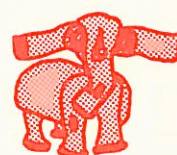
## **City Trips For Groups**

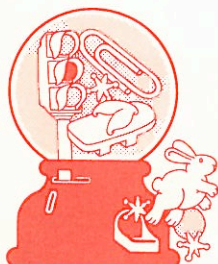
